Maths - (summer 1 and summer 2)

- o continue to develop subitising and noticing
- o explore a range of representations of numbers
- o compare quantities and numbers
- continue to develop a sense of magnitude, e.g.
 knowing that 8 is quite a lot more than 2, but 4 is only a little bit more than 2
- Select shapes for a purpose, rotate shapes, manipulate shapes and explain shapes
- Compose and decompose shapes
- Patterns; create and explore pattern rules
- Replicate and build scenes and constructions
- Position visualise and describe from different positions
- Give instructions to build
- Explore mapping

Personal Social and Emotional Development

- Understand the importance of healthy food choices
