Subject	Activity
Maths	<p>Number Bonds to 20 Treasure Hunt</p> <p>Children collect 10 small objects from around the house (toy cars, socks, pencils etc.).</p> <p>Adult calls a number between 11 and 20.</p> <p>Children find two groups that make that number.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>13 = 10 and 3</p> <p>13 = 8 and 5</p> <p>Challenge: How many different ways can you make 20?</p>
Literacy	<p>Animal Expert Notes</p> <p>Choose a Japanese animal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Red-crowned crane• Japanese macaque• Koi carp <p>Create four fact boxes:</p> <p>What does it look like?</p> <p>What does it eat?</p> <p>An amazing fact</p> <p>These notes can later support their non-chronological report writing.</p>
Reading	<p>Read any book</p> <p>After reading draw a picture and write:</p> <p>My favourite animal/character was...</p> <p>I learnt...</p>
Topic	<p>Japanese Home Challenge</p> <p>Look around your home and find objects made from Wood, Paper and Fabric.</p> <p>Compare them to traditional Japanese homes.</p> <p>Draw and label your home and a Japanese home.</p> <p>Challenge: Write one similarity and one difference.</p>
Art	<p>Cherry Blossom Printing or drawing.</p> <p>Look at a picture of cherry blossom. Can you recreate with either paint, pens or pencils.</p>
