

Mrs Jones planted 30 seeds. Only half of the seeds grew into plants. How many plants did Mrs Jones grow?




Max had 12 fish in a tank. 7 fish were gold, and 3 were silver. The rest of the fish were orange. How many of Max's fish were orange?






